## **Earrings**

I would remind you that if your child wears earrings - only studs should be worn to school. Hoops and long earrings are not suitable. If possible earrings should be removed for PE and if your child is new to this, tape/plasters can be worn whilst they are practising doing this independently. We are aware that this can take a bit of time. Please note that the school cannot supply tape or plasters so please put these into your child's bag on PE days.

#### Clothing/Shoes

We have already had a number of lost/forgotten items handed in to lost property - PLEASE PUT YOUR CHILD/REN'S NAME ON ALL OF THEIR UNIFORM. Thank you.

#### COVID

Whilst we are delighted that restrictions have been lifted and that most routines are back to normal, COVID cases are obviously still occurring in the school and wider community. The current recommendation is that if your child has symptoms of COVID with a high temperature they should remain at home until they no longer have a temperature and are feeling better. We appreciate your continued support and vigilance in helping to reduce transmission in school.
