
St Cadoc's Primary Signpost to February 2021

- · Uniform will remain unchanged.
- Children will <u>not be</u> getting changed for P.E.
- Children can change into indoor shoes if they have them
- Primary 1-3 pupils will start school at 9am.
 Parents are not permitted into the school playground.
- Handwashing and sanitising will happen throughout the day, stations at class and school entrances.
- Social distancing will be in operation in playground, learning areas and dinning hall.
- Pupils will be in learning bubbles.
- Each class will have it's own designated playground space and lunch space.
- Face masks must be worn by adults when dropping off and collecting children.
- A one-way system is in operation in the school
- Please ensure you child has a jumper or cardigan with them as there is increased ventilation in the school building.



- All resources that your child will require for class learning will be provided by the school and will be for your child's personal use.
- Children can bring a school bag to hold lunch, snack and water bottle
- No toys or additional items from home can be brought to school.
- Children will be able to have school lunch or a packed lunch as normal.
 The lunch menu may be subject to short notice changes.
- Primary 1-3 learners in Rooms 1, 3 and 7 will return to face-to-face teaching
- P4 7 learners will continue to engage in remote learning via Google Classroom.
- Primary 4 7 pupils will still engage in new, progressive learning. There will be live interactions, story sessions, playground chat sessions and some live teaching via Google Meet. (updated timetable to follow)
