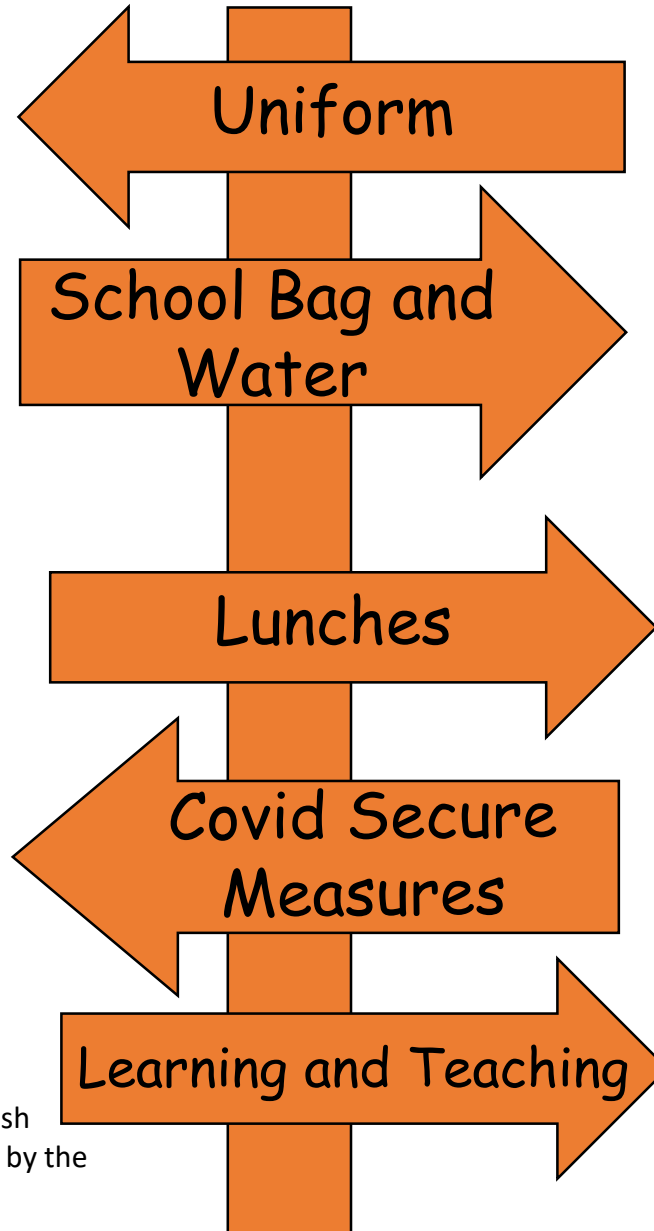


St Cadoc's Primary Signpost to August 2021

- School uniform will remain unchanged.
- Children will be getting changed for P.E. They should wear full school uniform and bring their kit with them on a Monday, returned on Friday.
- Children will change into indoor shoes.
- Primary 1-7 pupils will start school at 9am. Parents are still not able to enter the school playground.

- Handwashing and sanitising will happen throughout the day, stations are at class and school entrances.
- Staggered breaks will continue to be used for the playground and dining hall.
- Face masks should be worn by adults when dropping off and collecting children.
- Parents are encouraged to maintain a 1-2m social distance at the school gates.
- Please ensure your child has a jumper or cardigan with them as there is increased ventilation in the school building.

This information is correct based on Public Health Scotland and Scottish Government guidance as of 11/08/21. These mitigations will be revised by the end of September by the Scottish Government.



- All resources that your child will require for class learning will be provided by the school. There is no need to provide a pencil case.
- Children can bring a school bag to hold lunch, snack and water bottle
- No toys or additional items from home should be brought to school.

- Children will be able to have school lunch or a packed lunch as normal. The lunch menu may be subject to short notice changes.
- School meals are free for pupils in Primaries 1-4. For pupils in Primary 5 - 7 lunch will cost £1.95 unless entitled to a free school meal.
- Milk is available costing 20p.
- All monies must be paid through Parent Pay.

- Blended homework will be set on Google Classroom and using school resources.
- P.E will now be indoors as well as outdoors.
