Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to our first newsletter of our new session – and a warm welcome to all our children and families...both old and new! Our new children are settling well in both our 2-3 and 3-5 rooms as are our staff members.

Nursery Staff

- Our 2-3 room staff are— Hazel and Anne (job share partners), Emma and Stacey. Gillian, our Team Leader, will have specific responsibility for working in the 2-3 room. We are also due another new member of staff and I will let you know when that happens.
- Our 3-5 room staff this session are Gayle, Robyn, Suzanne, Veronica and Nicola (job share partners), Vicki and Mags (job share partners). Mrs Leamy, our Nursery Teacher, will have specific responsibility for working in the 3-5 room. Again, a new member of staff is due to arrive with us hopefully soon.

Nursery Times

- Our nursery times are now 8.45am 2.45pm for our fully time children; 8.45am 11.55am for our morning children and 11.35 -2.45pm for our afternoon children. Thank you for ensuring your child is with us promptly in the morning as this all helps with the settling in routine and them hearing about what is happening in the nursery each day. At 2.45pm, the children will be brought to you through the quadrangle area. Should you require to take your child from nursery earlier than 2.45pm, please report to the nursery office where Mrs Holding will be happy to help.
- Our nursery lunchtime is from 12pm until 12.30pm and the children are settling well into this routine. A wee reminder about nursery packed lunches a sandwich, piece of fruit or yogurt, a small treat and a drink is quite adequate, please remember no fizzy drinks, sugary sweets or large bars of chocolate. Thank you for your co-operation with this

Nursery Admin

- Mrs Holding provides our clerical support in the nursery each day and is based in the nursery office.
 Please feel free to pop in and say hello to her as she is keen to get to know all of you as quickly as possible. Our nursery telephone number is 286270 however you can also call our school number 285080 and staff would be happy to help.
- Our snack money donation remains at 50p per day and should continue to be paid either weekly or monthly. This money is used to provide a daily snack for the children, to help with party food, presents at acceptable. Christmas, etc. and a range of other activities that all benefit our children
- As you know, we have a new signing in procedure for our children and parents which is working very well. Thank you for helping it to run smoothly.

Information Evening



<u>Important Nursery Information - a reminder ...</u>

- *Nut allergies just a reminder to everyone that we are a nut free nursery. Children should not bring any snacks or items in packed lunch boxes that may contains nuts or nut based ingredients.
- ***Health Promotion** we are a health promoting nursery and are trying to encourage our children to think about what they eat and drink. The snacks we provide in nursery are required to meet certain standards and can only have a certain percentage of salt, sugar, etc.
- *Absences/Lateness/Leaving Early If your child is to be absent from nursery, please phone our school office as soon as possible to inform us. We have an answering machine for your use. Lateness, absences and leaving early are recorded daily and if either of these become serious, the nursery place for your child may have to be re-allocated to a child on our ever increasing waiting list.
- *Contact Details are your contact details up-to-date? If you have change number or e-mail address, please let our office staff know. This also applies to emergency contacts too.
- *Head Lice we have had recent reports of head lice amongst some of our school pupils. We ask all parents and carers in our school and nursery to please check hair regularly and to treat if necessary.
- *Nursery Lunches —If your child does not like anything on the lunch menu on any given day, they should bring a packed lunch to nursery. Most of our children enjoy their nursery lunch and they are enjoying the social aspect of eating together. They are all doing very well embracing the routine and are getting good at clearing up, putting food in the waste bin and rubbish in the other bin...take note mums and dads!!
- *Car Park please remember not to park in the disabled bays unless you have a relevant badge. Due to our procedures for our school children leaving school at the end of the day, I have had a few concerns raised about the use of our car park and I am asking everyone to be vigilant about parking safely. Thank you so much for your help with this.

Please note we try as hard as possible to stick closely to the dates we have planned but at times there may be an occasion where we have to re-arrange or even cancel an event due to unforeseen circumstances. 
Our 3-5 room children are settling well and doing fantastically well with their lunch routine.
