Health and Safety

We have noticed that several children are coming to school wearing quite long acrylic nails which are a potential hazard within our school. They are also limiting for certain activities which then affects learning. In line with our Health and Safety guidelines, children should please refrain from wearing these nails to school.

*PE Kit- we have noticed that several of our children are not bringing the correct PE kit with them each week and this is deterring their participation in PE activities. Your help in ensuring they have their PE kit is greatly appreciated – PE kit is polo shirt/t-shirt, black shorts and indoor shoes. They also require an outdoor kit consisting of long trousers, a long sleeved top and suitable footwear. PE kits can remain in school each week. Please note earrings should be removed or covered and no jewellery should be worn.

Important School Information – a reminder ...

***Car Park**ing – we now have a set of cones positioned on the zig zag lines outside our school to help ensure this is a safe area for our children and families. Thank you to all drivers for your support in helping to keep the area around our school as safe as possible.

***Nut allergies** – just a reminder to everyone **that we are a nut free** school. Children should not bring any snacks or items to school that may contains nuts or nut based ingredients. Thank you everyone.

***Fizzy drinks** – fizzy drinks are not permitted in our school as they contain a vast amount of sugar which we all know affects children's attention and behaviour. This also applies to fizzy sweets.

*Health Promotion – we are a health promoting school and encourage our children to think about what they eat and drink. This includes snacks at playtime and lunchtime. Milk is available each week at a cost of £1.00 and a biscuit can be bought for each day of the week for the total cost of 10p.

*Absences/Lateness/Leaving Early - If your child is to be absent from school, please phone our school office as soon as possible to inform us. We have an answering machine for your use. All children should be in the playground before the bell rings at 9am each day and we now have a bell ringing at 8.55am as a reminder to our children that 9am is fast approaching! The legal requirement is that children attend school from 9-3pm each day. If they are required to leave early, please bring your appointment letter to our office staff who will then note this. Lateness, absences and leaving early are recorded daily and if either of these become detrimental to any child's time at school, the council procedure is that an attendance officer will be asked to contact you to discuss further. Thank you for your support in ensuring your child is in school from 9-3pm each day.

***Contact Details** - If your telephone number or e-mail address change throughout the course of the year, please do let our office staff know to allow us to update our records. This also applies to emergency contacts.

*Head Lice – We ask all parents and carers to please check hair regularly and if there is any case of head lice, please let us know. Many thanks.
