
## Diary Dates for 2019/2020

# Important School Information - a reminder ...

\***Nut allergies** – just a reminder to everyone that we are a nut free school. Children should not bring any snacks or items to school that may contains nuts or nut based ingredients.

\***Fizzy drinks** – fizzy drinks are not permitted in our school as they contain a vast amount of sugar which affects children's attention and behaviour.

\*Health Promotion – we are a health promoting school and encourage our children to think about what they eat and drink. This includes snacks at playtime and lunchtime. Milk is available each week at a cost of £1.00 and a biscuit can be bought for each day of the week for the total cost of 10p. We are looking to set up a healthy tuckshop and more information about this will follow.

\*Absences/Lateness/Leaving Early - If your child is to be absent from school, please phone our school office as soon as possible to inform us. We have an answering machine for your use. All children should be in the playground before the bell rings at 9am each day and we now have a bell ringing at 8.55am as a reminder to our children that 9am is fast approaching! The legal requirement is that children attend school from 9-3pm each day. If they are required to leave early, please bring your appointment letter to our office staff who will then note this. Lateness, absences and leaving early are recorded daily and if either of these become detrimental to any child's time at school, the council procedure is that an attendance officer will be asked to contact you to discuss further.

\***Contact Details** - If your telephone number or e-mail address change throughout the course of the year, please do let our office staff know to allow us to update our records. This also applies to emergency contacts.

\*Head Lice – We ask all parents and carers to please check hair regularly and if there is any case of head lice, it is helpful if you let the school know as soon as possible please.

\*School Uniform – the children are very smart in our school uniform and we thank you so much for your great support with this. Please note that trainers are not part of our school uniform and named items such as Nike, etc should be kept for home. Children need a full PE kit each week and will also require joggers and a warm top as each class has a timetabled slot each week for outdoor PE. Children are not allowed to wear jewellery during PE due to Health and Safety and earrings should be removed or covered.

#### **Important Forms**

Lots of important forms are home today and we really need these returned to us as soon as possible please and no later than Fri 31<sup>st</sup> August. This allows our office staff to update the information we keep about your child. Thank you very much for your co-operation and time with this. If your information changes at all, please remember to keep us informed.

#### School App

We have a school app that is accessible through the Google Play or Apple Store by searching for St Elizabeth's Primary and Nursery School. From next month, our newsletters will be uploaded on to this App. We use the App for regular updates as well as our Twitter and Facebook Pages.

#### **Homework Diaries**

Each child has their own homework diary and these are used in our school as a way of recording and sharing information. We would greatly appreciate you signing the diary each night and returning it to us in school bags each day. It is a great way of providing another level of communication between school and home ... please feel free to use it like that.

### **Photographer**

\*We will have the Hamilton Advertiser coming to school shortly to take a photograph of our Primary 1 pupils. We don't have the exact date as yet but I will let you know as soon as we hear.

\* We have organised a photographer to come to school on Wed 4<sup>th</sup> and Thurs 5<sup>th</sup> Sept. Careen will be with us to take individual and sibling photographs this year. Shirt and ties to be worn please.

#### Lunches and Milk

\*The criteria for receiving Free Meal Entitlement changed last session and anyone in receipt of this before should please double check you are still entitled to receive it this session.

\*As usual, our children can purchase milk to drink at playtime. The cost of this is 20p per day and the children order their milk for through Parent Pay. This allows our Cook-in-Charge, Janet, to order the milk we need and to bank the money each Monday. If any child forgets their snack any day, we have a small biscuit selection at a cost of 2p a biscuit. Children can buy on the day or bring their money the following day.

#### **Breakfast Club**

We run a breakfast club each day in our school and this takes place from 8.15am until 8.45am. This is free of charge and open to all pupils in our school. Children should come to the front door of the school where a member of staff will register them and let them through to our dining hall for breakfast.

#### **Clubs in our School**

#### **Contacting our School**

Please note our office staff are delighted to help you in any way and, as you know, do a wonderful job keeping our busy school office running smoothly. It is not always possible to get messages to children after 2.45pm due to them being in various parts of the school and this has caused a bit of anxiety for our office staff in trying to do so. Our answering machine is switched on from 2.45pm until after 3pm in order to try to help reduce the busyness at what can often be a frantic time of day. Should you have a message that needs passed on, please contact our school office as early as possible in the day. Please, please only call the school office in an emergency. Many thanks for your help with all of this.

#### **Houses**

Our Houses have been revamped and all our children have been placed into one of our 4 houses. The house colours and names are St Andrew (Blue); St Columba (Green); St Mungo (Red); St Margaret (Yellow). The children will gain points for their house and winning houses will receive a treat as we progress through the year. More information will follow about this. We will be having a Rainbow Cake and Candy shortly to help kick off our year and establish our Houses.

#### Good to be Green Behaviour System

We continue to operate our Good to be Green System and this is working very well in our school. Each class has a Good to be Green Chart and this is used daily throughout our school.
