** Focus on Literacy and Numeracy Support**

We have a range of support in place for our children and you may know about IDL Numeracy and IDL Literacy. Some of our children use this resource for a period of time to help them increase their confidence and skills in certain areas.

We have another resource called Reading Eggs across our school. This provides reading and maths resources, games and activities and we will be using this regularly. Each child has a login and can access material at home. We hope you are enjoying using this program with your child.

** Can you Help Us?

In line with our Improvement Plan, we are continuing to develop outdoor play and learning. We have identified some resources we are needing help with to support learning. We are wondering if families would be able to help donate any of the following items for us...we would greatly appreciate your help before look in to buying these resources. We are looking for –

- construction resources... child friendly tools and work benches.
- water trough/ pipes which can be moved to control water flow
- sand pits
- garden equipment.. sundial, rainfall collector, thermometers etc
