** Health and Safety **

In line with guidance, we are continuing to follow all health and safety procedures in our school and nursery. Regular hand washing continues to be in place in all our classrooms and playrooms, daily and weekly cleaning routines and high levels of ventilation. Whilst we monitor the temperature in classrooms, our children are welcome to wear their school hoody as well as a jumper to school as the school can become very airy. We are continuing to maintain 2m distancing between adults and children and all adults are wearing face masks in all of our communal areas.

All adults are asked to continue to please wear face masks within our school/nursery vicinity and we thank you very much for your continued support with this.



** Breakfast Club**

Our breakfast club runs from 8.15 to 8.45am each day and is open to any school child to attend. Children should arrive promptly and go through the dining room doors in the playground. We have a good attendance each morning and it is lovely to be able to have a wee chat with the children at this time.

** Free School Meal **

From January 2022, our P5 pupils will be entitled to a free school lunch each day, should they wish. This is in line with the Scottish Government's Free Meal Expansion programme.

Our Fun Run has raised over £1,600 and our Christmas Raffle raised £284. This money will go to school funds and our school fund committee will meet in the new year to discuss what to spend the money on for the benefit of our children.

Our nursery Christmas raffle has raised a total of approximately £500 and we will have a final figure next week.

** Hamilton South Church **

Our Primary 7 children recently wrote letters to businesses asking for Christmas decorations. Home Bargains replied to us to inform us they do not donate items to individual schools however their staff had a whip round and collected £25 for our school. We were blown away by their generosity! We now have 2 lovely sets of lights for our school and our Primary 7 children will select a good place for us to put them.

** Parental Engagement **

School Enrolment Week

All children who will turn 5 before the 28th February 2023 should be enrolled for school the week beginning the 17th January. Enrolments will be online again this year.

Parents within our catchment area will be advised via social media that you can begin using the online registration form to enrol your child for school in August 2022. You will need your child's full birth certificate and 2 proofs of address. Once you have completed the online registration, the form along with the child's full birth certificate and 2 proofs of residency will come directly to our office email address.

Any parents who are unable to complete an online registration form due to technology issues or that their property is not listed on the mapping system can complete a Reg1 document. This can be completed over the telephone. We must however receive your child's full birth certificate and necessary proofs of residence by email or post before the registration can be completed.

** Christmas Celebrations**

We have had a lovely week of celebrations with our children, albeit different to how we would normally do these things, but our wonderful staff have ensured all of our children have had great fun.

We all enjoyed a delicious Christmas Lunch on Wednesday 15th December and many thanks to Janet and her team for this and all the lunches throughout the year.


