Further to our school uniform, we are reintroducing the use of black plimsolls within our school in order to help maintain a clean environment. You may remember we had this is place pre COVID and it is lovely to be able to return to this again.

All children are required to have black plimsolls with them please – we have brand new ones available in school which can be purchased for a small donation should anyone require.

For PE the school children wear their blue polo shirt and plain black shorts or leggings. They will also wear their plimsolls to the PE hall in line with Health and Safety. PE is done twice a week and the PE days are as follows –
