• South Lanarkshire Council Recruitment



• Scooters and E-Scooters

South Lanarkshire Council does not consent to e-scooters being brought onto or used within school grounds. This applies to all areas of the campus, including playgrounds, paths, car parks and entrances.

Pupils who arrive at school using a traditional, non-electric scooter should stop at the gates and walk the scooter into the campus, in the same way that bicycles are managed. These items should be stored in bike racks or another safe area outside and are brought to school entirely at the owner's risk.
