Parent Employment Support

What is it?

This service supports parents who are either working or looking for work, essential just now as families face the cost of living crisis and look to maximise household income.

Support for parents out of work

Dedicated keyworker support is available including:

- Advice and guidance
- Job-focussed training and job search support
- Help with managing a health condition
- Help with financial concerns and family budgeting skills
- Access to childcare

Supporting Working Parents

The programme will also help working parents who are looking to gain new skills and progress in the workplace. Parents will have access to a dedicated keyworker who will help them address in work barriers such as low skills and qualifications, health and money issues and childcare challenges. This will help enhance parents' employment prospects, such as promoted or new job opportunities.

Who is eligible for support?

- Lone parents
- Parents with three or more children
- Parents under 25
- Parents with a child under 12 months
- Parents from ethnic minority backgrounds
- Parents or child with a disability
