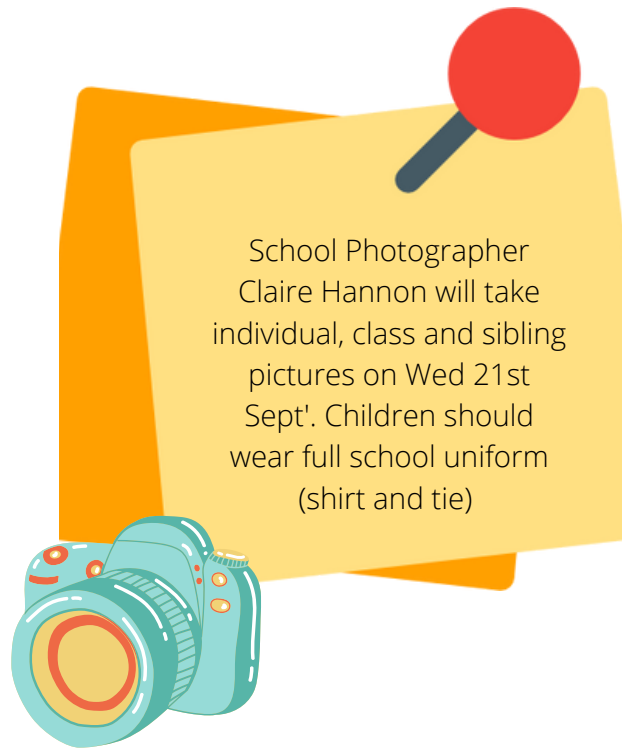
Congratulations to our nominated JRSO Officers from P6 - Brodie and Monica. We know they will do a fantastic job!

## School Flu Immunisation date



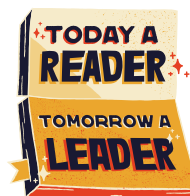
Wednesday 2nd Nov'22
