#### **English Curricular Transition**

#### Input from English Teachers

English teachers will accompany two \$1 Larkhall Academy pupils to primary schools in January. The English teacher will deliver a lesson focusing on effective presentation skills, this will involve:

- Two \$1 pupils delivering solo presentations- one pupil will deliver an effective presentation and the other pupil will be encouraged to make obvious errors.
- · P7 pupils will then self-assess each presentation using the talk assessment sheet using traffic light highlighters.
- · Teacher led feedback.
- · Class discussion about the focus of P7 solo presentation and potential heroes.

#### Class Work

P7 pupils will then complete the following tasks:

- Reading- baseline reading assessment. A close reading passage about a 'hero' with questions which assess basic understanding. A differentiated reading assessment will also be provided.
- Listening- baseline listening assessment. A short clip about a famous hero and accompanying questions which assess basic understanding.
- · Research- pupils identify a 'real life' hero and research this. A research help sheet can be provided.
- Talking- solo presentation. Pupils write and deliver their solo talk. As a department, we understand not all pupils will be able to stand in front of their peers and so pupils can deliver their presentations in small groups, if this is better suited to learning and teaching. Pupils will peer assess and teachers will use the talk assessment sheet.
- · Writing- 200 Word Challenge. Using their research and notes from the solo presentation

#### Maths

Lessons will be shared through Google Classroom and/or published to YouTube. Pupils will participate in 5 lessons throughout the year. Introducing pupils to Larkhall Academy's Maths department and the structure of the lessons taught.

The lessons will focus on key skills and like our \$1/2 mix ability lessons, they will be differentiated. An overview of the content is below.
