Numeracy



- Continue to count, recognise, use before & after/ more & less/ bigger & smaller and order numbers up to 20/50/100 and some beyond 100
- Develop counting skills by skip counting in 2, 5 and 10.
- Some children will continue to develop their knowledge and understanding of multiplication
- Some will be introduced to division
- Most children will revisit the concept of addition and subtraction to maintain skills
- Continue to work on number formation skills and record sums accurately
- Some will be learning about place value.
