Literacy

Learning will be differentiated to meet the needs of the individual learner.

<u>Reading</u> – The children will develop their reading skills using fiction and non-fiction texts.

<u>Writing</u> – The children will develop their story sequencing skills with a range of pictorial and written activities.

<u>Phonics/Spelling</u> – The children will develop their understanding of initial and blended sounds through a range of active spelling activities.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> – The children will play games, share news stories and answer questions to develop their skills.

Learning across the curriculum
