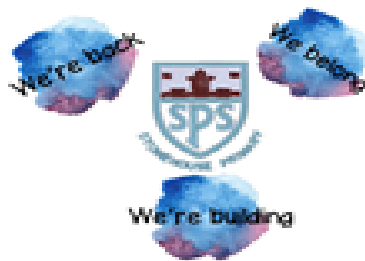

Literacy

Reading: Children will be reading a range of genres answering a range of literal and inferential questions.

They will continue to develop strategies we use before, during and after reading. SRA will be used throughout the term.

Spelling: Spelling strategies and patterns will be taught. Spelling lists will be provided for use at home.

Writing: Children will continue to develop and embed their existing VCOP (vocabulary, Connectives, openers and punctuation) strategies.

Talking and Listening: SRA and Higher Order Thinking Skills will be used throughout the term.



Health and Wellbeing

Indoor and outdoor P.E will be taught each week. Gymnastics skills are being taught indoors. Basketball skills and games are being taught outdoors.

Children will be participating in the emotion works programme helping them to develop their emotional literacy.

Learning across the curriculum
