Our Term 1 Highlights



Term 1 is now behind us, but we can now reflect on the learning and development that happened over the last term. We responded to the children's interests in weddings setting up an old suitcase with wedding props for the children to explore. This led onto our fantastic ceilidh which finished off our term. With the extended days in place we have been able to access the community with visits to the library, the shops and Biggar museum. Towards the end of the term we responded to the children's interests in block play and have now created a much larger space for the children to use, this allows for the different stages within block play. Did you know there are 7 stages in block play? Ask our team if you would like to know more.

Over the coming term we will provide opportunities for the children to develop & extend their own ideas through block play, creativity and drama. We are now well into autumn and will be using this as a possible line of development (PLOD) to build on children's own knowledge and experiences in Health and Wellbeing, Numeracy and Literacy along with other curricular areas.
