Curriculum for Excellence

Literacy and English

We will be looking at the story 'Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes" and incorporating that into Talk For Writing. Eventually, we will see if we can change the song to different body parts. They will need to listen to each others' ideas and think about words that sound the same (rhyming).

We will also look at poetry this term.

Every week we will continue to have a 'Word of the Week' and this will be taken from each pod's 'Book of the Week'.

Numeracy and Maths

Children will continue to explore numbers everyday throughout their play. We will continue to have a 'Number of the Week' where we can look more closely at the number and what it looks like in lots of way (fingers, dice, money, dots, numeral, numicon and on a ten frame).

The children will also learn about money. We will look at coins and their similarities/differences. This will hopefully lead to us knowing some of the coins.

Targets

RME - Shares thoughts and asks and answers questions to show and support understanding

Science - Describes how the rotation of the Earth in relation to the sun gives us day and night.

Numeracy and Mathematics - Children will be able to look at the differences between coins and identify some.

Health & Wellbeing - Develop their moving skills through energetic play (achieveing).

Language and Literacy - Hears and says rhyming words and generates rhyme from a given word

We will learn about 'Space' this term and be child led with this. We do hope to cover the Earth's rotation around the sun and how the moon rotates around Earth.
