Health and Wellbeing

The SHANNARI focuses are Respected and Achieving through P.E lessons. The children will discuss what makes a good leader, why rules are important and we should not cheat, reflect on their own and peers' performance and explore and develop a range of movements and activities as an individual, with a partner and in a group. In Health and Wellbeing, we will also focus on learning about different emotions and how we cope with those emotions.

Expressive Arts

Our Expressive arts will focus on Music. The children will listen to variety of music and express their opinions about it. They will learn about beat, rhythm, volume, tempo, crotchet, rest and syllables. The children will learn the names of the musical instruments, the families they belong to and create their own piece of music in a group.

Target Setting in the Classroom

Each term, your child will be involved in target setting which will support/challenge their learning and encourage them to try their best. The targets will stem from our termly overview targets and will be written into their homework diaries and pupil portfolios.

As the children achieve their targets, and celebrate their success, their work will be placed in their purple pupil portfolio which you can view on open days and parents' evenings. This folder forms a record of your child's development throughout their time at Tinto Primary School.

Language and Literacy

Our writing this term will focus on poetry. We will read poems from different famous poets and look at poems covering a range of themes. The children will write acrostic poems, list poems, haiku and shape poems. They will learn about adjectives, rhyme and rhythm, verses, syllables and similes. We will continue to learn new sounds and practise these within reading and writing. We will continue to learn new common words. We will continue to use Bloom's questioning and Higher Order Thinking Skills to complete, predicting, connecting, comparing and creating activities.

Numeracy and Mathematics

The maths focus will be Money. The children will learn to recognise all the coins and order them by value. They will count and make amounts using a variety of coins. They will make amounts in different ways, add and subtract amounts and find change. The numeracy focus this term will be addition and subtraction using a variety of strategies. We will continue to develop skip counting and place value within this.

Overview Targets

Language - P1 will focus on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. P2 will focus on using adjectives and writing with more detail and description and using a range of punctuation.

Maths - P1-To recognise different coins.

P2- To understand and use the vocabulary 'Numerator' and 'Denominator'.

Science- Can sort objects into those which use mains electricity or get electricity from an alternate source eg. batteries.

PE- To be a good winner and react appropriately to losing.
