# Numeracy and Mathematics

This term we are focussing on consolidating skills in number including the four operations. We will focus on skills we find tricky and develop our range of mental and formal strategies.

We will also look at money, and algebraic thinking developing our ability to calculate change, work on a budget and solve money word problems. We will look at missing number calculations and learn about how to represent numbers with pictures and letters.

#### **Assessments**

In Primary 4/5 we assess in a variety of ways from daily observations and jotter work to end of unit maths assessments and progression in writing checklists where pupils can see their achievements and next steps.

We will encourage your child throughout the year to share their progress and success at home and through their Purple Portfolio. Our school app will be used to share photos and we will focus on self marking and peer assessment to develop independence and resilience.

## Language and Literacy

In writing, we will be looking at poetry and short imaginative prose. We will analyse a range of poetry and use techniques including simile, metaphor, rhyme and rhythm.

## Health and Wellbeing

This term we will be refocussing our learning on emotionworks considering triggers to our behaviours and strategies for addressing them. We have worked on friendships and teamwork all session and will continue to use class discussion, problem solving and peer support to help us increase resilience and build confidence in each other.

In physical education, we will be working on athletics for sports day with Mrs MacNeill and rounders skills with Mrs Rodger.

#### Science

This term we will learn about light and conduct experiments and investigations into how light travels.

We will also do a series of one off science days covering a range of topical science topics.
