Numeracy and Mathematics

This term we are focussing on addition and subtraction and shape.

In line with staff training on maths recovery we are building on last term's work on place value and the number system and will focus on number talks strategies.

We will work on shape focussing on symmetry, tesselation and creative use of shape to solve problems.

We will continue to use a wide range of concrete materials, maths games, and online sites including prodigy maths for which all children have been issued with login details.

Homework

In Primary 4/5 we use Google Classroom to set homework. All homework is consolidation and can be returned through the classroom. I will not be marking homework as it is designed to give practice and experience in line with classwork.

Each week there will be spelling words and tasks, reading and a comprehension task and maths activities. Occasionally there will be one additional curriculum task.

Children will be provided with a homework jotter if needed or tasks can be completed digitally.

Language and Literacy

We will focus on reading skills this term with an assessment on questioning. We are revising Bloom's taxonomy to look at different kinds and levels of questioning and using them to frame discussion sessions and questioning tasks.

In writing will use our panto as a focus and we will create posters, programmes, scripts and reviews of performance to develop our drama and functional writing skills.

This term we are introducing Spanish as our second modern language in addition to French. As Mrs Rodger is currently studying Spanish for the classroom this will be a key part of our learning for the rest of the year.

Expressive Arts

Sinbad the Sailor is our pantomime this term which we are producing with P6/7. Everyone is involved in performing and will work on supporting the production across the term.

Science
