Target Setting in the Classroom

Throughout this year, your child will be setting a series of targets for themselves, challenging their learning, and striving for excellence. The targets which your child sets will stem from our termly overview targets and be personalised to specific areas which your child may wish to challenge themselves in or have found challenging in their learning.

As our children achieve their targets, and celebrate their success, their work will be placed in their Purple Pupil Portfolio. This folder forms a record of your child's development throughout their time at Tinto Primary School. We have now transitioned to a digital version of the portfolio.



Literacy

Writing - This term we will begin with a revision of 'Procedure' then move onto 'Information Report' writing which make strong links with our topic work

Reading - In reading we are developing our reading comprehension skills through reading circle conversations which develop our ability to question a text and synthesise information.

We will also continue to develop our spelling skills through phonic development and recognition.

Numeracy and Mathematics

Numeracy- This term we will be focussing on subtraction, multiplication and division using a variety of strategies. As always, we support our numeracy learning with a selection of concrete materials including NMaps and Numicon.

Maths- Alongside our Numeracy learning we will continue to consolidate and revise the concept of time and shape.

Scots Month

Throughout January we will be exploring Scottish culture and language. Our goal is to design our own Scottish superhero and make a comic strip using a variety of Scots language, similar to Oor Wullie and Dandy Dan.

Social Studies

This term we will be participating in a whole school topic investigating the Rainforest. This topic will help them understand more about the world we live in and why rainforests are so important. Your child will:

- Learn where rainforests are found around the world
- Discover what the rainforest climate is like and what makes it unique
- Explore the plants and animals that live in rainforests
- Find out why rainforests are important, including how they help the planet
- Begin to understand why rainforests need to be protected
