Target Setting in the Classroom

Throughout this year, your child will be setting a series of targets for themselves, challenging their learning, and striving for excellence. The targets which your child sets will stem from our termly overview targets and be personalised to specific areas which your child may wish to challenge themselves in or have found challenging in their learning.

As our children achieve their targets, and celebrate their success, their work will be placed in their Purple Pupil Portfolio. This folder forms a record of your child's development throughout their time at Tinto Primary School. We havenow transitioned to a digital version of the portfolio.



Literacy

Writing- This term in writing we are focussing on imaginative and creative writing, applying our VCOP skills. We hope to create our own books showcasing our stories as part of our enterprise topic.

Reading- In reading we are developing our cloze procedure skills and recognising a variety of punctuation as we read to enhance our expression and fluency.

We will also continue to develop our spelling skills through phonic development and recognition.

Numeracy and Mathematics

Numeracy- This term we will be continuing our focus on multiplication and division, fractions, expressions and equations, using a variety of strategies. As always, we support our numeracy learning with a selection of concrete materials including NMaps and Numicon.

Maths- Alongside our Numeracy learning we will be exploring data analysis, angles and symmetry and chance and uncertainty. Data analysis will play a key role in our enterprise topic as we explore what customers would like through surveys.

Enterprise

Through this project, children will learn about how businesses work in a fun and practical way. Working in small teams, they will design a company, create a product and plan how to sell it.

- **Literacy:**
Pupils will develop talking and listening skills through group discussions and presentations. They will also create posters and adverts to promote their products.
- **Numeracy:**
Children will use money in real-life contexts by budgeting for ingredients, setting prices, and calculating profit.
- **Health and Wellbeing:**
Pupils will learn about teamwork, cooperation, and taking on a role within a group whilst also supporting others.
- **Social Studies:**
Learners will explore how businesses operate and the roles people play within them.
- **Technologies & Expressive Arts:**
Pupils will design their products, logos, and marketing materials, developing creativity and problem-solving skills.

As well as subject knowledge, this topic helps children build important life skills such as:

- Teamwork and communication
- Creativity and problem-solving
- Confidence and responsibility
