

### Health and Wellbeing

This term we will be exploring the wellbeing indicators 'active' and 'included'. The children will be looking at the importance of keeping themselves active to help improve their health and wellbeing. They will be engaging in circle time and drama scenarios which explore inclusion and feeling included.

The children will receive two sessions of P.E per week. The focus for this term is 'Athletics'. The children will be taking part in games and activities that develop their strength, speed and power. They will be trying to beat their own personal bests and do some training for Sports Day.

### Social Studies

Our topic focus this term is enterprise. We will be learning about how money is made as well as creating and designing products. We will look at marketing, advertising, sales and design while working together to work on our collaboration skills.

### Science

This term we will be learning about 'Sensory Organs'. We will be looking at the structure and function of the organs and how they respond to outside conditions.

### Technologies

We will use digital technologies throughout the curriculum to support learning and develop skills for life, learning and work. We will focus on core skills including manipulating text and images on docs and slides. This term we will have the opportunity to develop food technology skills with 4 cooking sessions. We will focus on safety, hygiene and using cooking utensils.

### Term 3 Overview 2025-26

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### Target Setting in the Classroom

Throughout this year, your child will be setting a series of targets for themselves, challenging their learning, and striving for excellence. The targets which your child sets will stem from our termly overview targets and be personalised to specific areas which your child may wish to challenge themselves in or have found challenging in their learning.

As our children achieve their targets, and celebrate their success, a selection of their work will be added to their individual online pupil portfolio which you can view at any time using the QR code. This forms a record of your child's development throughout their time at Tinto Primary School.

## Numeracy and Mathematics

Numeracy this term will have a focus on data analysis and chance and uncertainty as well as answering problem solving tasks.

Within mathematics, our focus this term is angles and to revisit volume. The children will learn how to use a protractor to accurately measure an angle. They will know the names of different types of angles and will be able to estimate the size of an angle. The children will revise their knowledge of volume and further practice this. The children will also revisit the mathematics concepts taught throughout the year within word problems.

## Expressive Arts

Primary 7 will be working on their leaver's assembly, while primary 6 are delivering a showcase to the school about our learning of the rainforest. Primary 5 will continue to have music lessons from a Mr Johnstone (a specialist Music Teacher) on Tuesday mornings.

In **art**, children will explore different styles, including one point perspective and shadow art, focusing on line drawing and tone. There will be opportunities throughout the curriculum to use our art skills.

The children will develop their drama skills through the shows and circle time scenarios.

## Language and Literacy

**Reading:** In our reading groups we will focus on discussion, reading independently, and written responses to comprehension tasks and bloom's questions. We will also finish our class novel 'Who Let the Gods Out?'.

**Spelling:** The children will continue to build their word awareness and vocabulary using the SWST spelling lists and common words lists and a range of active spelling strategies. We will work on using dictionaries and thesauruses to develop our word knowledge.

**Writing:** This term we are focussing on 'Narrative' writing and using our imaginations to create our own stories. The children will look at the structure of a narrative piece as well looking at setting and characterisation.

**Talking & Listening:** The children will continue to develop their talking and listening skills through activities, presentations and group and class discussions.

**Modern Languages:** This term we will continue to learn some Spanish. We will cover pets, food, weather and some basic greetings. We will then finish the term by revising some French phrases and having a French cafe in the class to practice.

## RME

This term we will be learning about key figures within world religions. The children will explore the significant figures that made a difference or brought about change and why that figure is important to some people.
