

Language & Literacy

We will be developing our use of Active Literacy this term focusing on comprehension strategies, writing and spelling tasks.

Spelling- Using our knowledge of phonics to blend sounds (phonemes) together into words. Applying strategies to help us spell tricky/ common words - investigating which words can be sounded out and those that cannot. Reading —reading fiction and nonfiction texts aloud with increasing fluency and expression. Engaging in peer reading and asking questions about the text. Our class novel for this term is 'Harry and the Bucketful of Dinosaurs' linking in with our Dinosaurs topic. Writing- Through our Talk for Writing programme, we will be working on a variety of texts including 'How to play snakes and ladders' practicing our instruction writing and 'Why animals might be scary?' for explanatory writing.

Social Studies

The topic for this term is 'Dinosaurs', using Harry and the Bucketful of Dinosaurs as our stimulus.

We will focus on-

Using historical evidence and the experience of recreating an historical setting.

What a dinosaur is- names, characteristics, identifying herbivores/ omnivores and carnivores.

Exploring places, investigating artefacts, and locating them in time.

Health & Wellbeing



In P.E. the children will have opportunities to develop skills in striking and fielding activities including, softball and rounders. They will also develop skills in orienteering.

In Health and Wellbeing, children will focus on 'Nurturing and Achieving'.

As a Rights Respecting School, we will continue to offer opportunities for children to develop their understanding of their rights and how to apply them.

Religious & Moral

This term we will look at festivals in world religions, including Hanukkah, the Jewish festival of light.

Later in the term, we will investigate the Christmas Story.

We will explore Christmas themes through the class novel, "Harry and the Dinosaur Make a Christmas Wish".



Numeracy & Mathematics

This term we will further develop our mental agility skills using Number Talks. We will also be developing skills in:

- Quantities
- Addition within 20
- Subtraction within 20
- Time
- Money
