



<p>This term we will focus on-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Phonics- initial sounds and 'special friends' (diagraphs) eg, ch, th. • Blending/Fred Talk • 'Red' words and common words • Developing independent reading skills • Spelling skills using 'Fred Fingers' • Writing a sentence with a capital letter and a full stop. 	<p>This term we will be focusing on-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 'Scotland and Robert Burns' We will be learning Scottish Traditions and reciting poems and songs. <p>Later on in the term we will focus on –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 'The Circus' We will take part in different circus themed activities. 	<p>In PE, we will be learning about gymnastics and athletics.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In HWB, we will learn that energy comes from food and the importance of eating healthily • We will begin to develop consideration for other's needs and feelings • We will also be developing our understanding of Children's Rights and our own roles and responsibilities • We will continue to practice mindfulness through the Do Be Mindful programme. 	<p>Our Focus this term will be on-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 'Festivals – Chinese New Year' We will develop our understanding of the major festivals & celebrations that go on around the world. <p>Later in the term, we will be looking at –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 'Easter- New Life' We will develop our awareness of importance of the Christian festival Easter and new life in spring.
<p>Numeracy & Mathematics</p>  <p>This term, we will further develop our mental agility skills using Number Talks. We will also be developing skills in-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number Talks • Time- days, months, seasons, clocks & calendars • Doubling numbers to 10 • Sharing quantities • 2D shape and 3D objects • Subtraction 	<p>Technologies</p>  <p>We will continue to use our ICT skills to enhance our learning across the curriculum. We will also develop our skills in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using iPads to access a variety of applications • Internet safety • Using educational games to consolidate learning e.g. Education City • Food technology 	<p>Science</p>  <p>Our focus this term will be on – Forces, electricity and waves</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Through creative play with a variety of toys and objects, I can recognise simple types of forces and describe their effects. • Learn about the importance of electricity in our daily lives. Identify the risks that can be caused by electricity and how to stay safe. 	<p>Expressive Arts</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In Art we will develop skills in using mixed media, and create Scottish themed art. • Look at work by Scottish artist Steven Brown. • In Drama we will use our poetry recital as a stimulus for role play. • In Music we will learn and perform Scottish songs, and songs for our Easter Service. We will also be using a wide variety of songs to explore movement, rhythm and pitch.



Home Learning Opportunities

Language & Literacy  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise your sounds flashcards- Fred Talk green words. Read your reading book with an adult; discuss the story; predict what might happen next. Play 'Splat' with your word flashcards Practise writing your full name 	Social Studies  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recite your Scottish poem to someone at home & perform with actions. The Circus: choose a performer from the circus and draw their act- juggling, trapeze artist. 	Health & Wellbeing  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teach someone at home a game you have learned in PE. Play ball games with friends. Help at home to prepare a healthy breakfast and tidy up afterwards. Play outside! 	Religious & Moral  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tell someone at home all that you have learnt about Chinese New Year. What is important about the snake? New life scavenger hunt – During Springtime go out and about looking for signs of things growing. For example, new buds on plants or small green leaves popping out.
Numeracy & Mathematics  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each morning, talk about the day of the week, the month and the season. Practise doubles e.g. what does $5+5$ equal? What does $3+3$ equal? Share items at home e.g. 10 strawberries shared between 2 people, how many do we get each? Spot 2D shapes and 3D objects around your home Revise number bonds to 10. 	Technologies  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take photographs of what you see out on your walks. Make a video diary of the games you've played with your family. Record yourself performing your poem. 	Science  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore push and pull toys at home Chat to an adult about ways to be safe around electricity 	Expressive Arts  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Perform your poem to your family. Play some Scottish music, perhaps with bagpipes, and dance and clap to the beat. Draw the Scottish flag. Make a collage of all things Scottish.
