EXTENSION AND NURSERY CLASS UPDATE

As you may be aware, work is set to begin during the summer holidays on the second phase of the school building which will incorporate additional classrooms and nursery class. During these works, part of the car park will be restricted to allow access to the building site. When the school re-opens after the holidays in August 2018, the entrance and exit of the car park will be swapped and the flow of traffic will operate in the opposite direction from the way it is now. This change will be permanent. We ask for your co-operation to keep our car park as safe as possible for the children by using it as a drop-off only in the morning and making other arrangement at 3pm if you can. As a health promoting school, we encourage children to walk to school where possible.

SCOTTTISH NATIONAL STANDARDISED ASSESSMENTS

Over the next few weeks, pupils in Primary 1, 4 and 7 will complete online standardised assessments in literacy and numeracy.

The assessments help to identify children's progress to support teachers' professional judgement. Children do not have to revise or prepare for these assessments.
