

ACHIEVEMENTS AND SUCCESSES

May was a very successful month for Woodhead as we took part in a wide range of sporting events in the local community.

Davie Cooper Football 7s

Pupils from P6-7 participated in the annual Davie Cooper tournament at the start of the month. The girls' team progressed to the semi-finals and all children displayed excellent sportsmanship and determination. Well done to all involved.

Hamilton Swimming Gala

Pupils from P3-7 participated in the Hamilton Schools Swimming Gala two weeks ago. The children cheered their team mates to victory which included a bronze for freestyle breadth, a silver in the 25m freestyle, a gold in the 50m breaststroke and bronze in the girls' 100m relay.

Athletics Event

Our athletics team had an outstanding result at the Track and Field event last week. They brought home 24 medals – our relay teams all won gold! An excellent result for our young athletes.

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Self-Evaluation and School Improvement

As part of our ongoing involvement of parents/carers, pupils and staff in the School Improvement process, we have been collecting views and feedback in new ways this term.

- Parents have been invited to complete a School Improvement Questionnaire during Parents' Night (there will be an opportunity for those who have yet to attend a rescheduled meeting to complete this).

- The Parent Council have undertaken a 'SWOT' analysis of the school which focusses on the Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats of School Improvement.

The information from these will be collated and added to the staff self-evaluation work which will be used to inform our School Improvement priorities for session 2018/19. A copy of this will be issued to all families in the new school term.
