

Head Teacher's Message

Adverse Weather Plan (Reprinted from October 2018 Newsletter)

In the event of heavy snow fall, the Adverse Weather Plan will be implemented. This has been developed by SLC Facility Services to take account of safe systems of work for Janitorial staff working in extreme weathers.

- The HT will make the decision that the Adverse Weather plan is to be implemented and inform parents/carers via Twitter and text message (if possible).
- The janitor will unlock the gates at the car park entrance only.
- The janitor will create a safe pathway from the gate to the main entrance and ensure all fire doors are clear.
- All pupils and staff will enter via the Main Entrance.
- No other gates will be opened and there will be no access paths created in the playground.
- Local weather conditions will be monitored and parents/carers will be kept informed via Twitter and text message.

We thank you for your co-operation and understanding in the event of any weather-related disruption. All decisions taken will be in the best interest of pupils and staff.

School Dress Code

We work hard as a school to create excellent conditions for learning and believe that a high standard of presentation creates an appropriate ethos.

In order to help achieve this, children are discouraged from wearing make-up to school and this includes false nails or extensions as these can pose a possible health and safety issue.

For the same reason, we place a huge importance on adhering to our school uniform dress code. Our uniform includes grey V-neck jumper/sweatshirt or cardigan. We ask that when you are purchasing new items of uniform, you avoid buying other colours as these are not part of our dress code. Items of school uniform can be purchased from any shop that sells school uniform items and do not need to have the school badge on them.

We have a number of nearly-new items of school uniform which we are delighted to pass on to anyone for a small donation to school funds. Please pop in to the office if you would like to have a look.

Mobile Telephones and Personal Electronics

Children are encouraged not to bring mobile telephones to school. However, we recognise that there will be circumstances where a child needs their phone before or after school. In this instance, pupils must have their phones switched off and kept in their school bags at all times during the school day. This includes in the playground before and after school.

We discourage children from bringing electronic watches such as Apple Watches, Fitbits etc to school especially if these can connect to the internet or receive/send messages etc. Pupils are not permitted to bring personal electronic devices to school such as computer games, tablets, book readers etc. It is also prohibited for any member of the school community (staff, pupils or visitors) to use their personal devices to take photos or videos in and around the school.

The school cannot accept any liability for the loss or damage of any personal items brought to school by pupils.

P4 to P7 Mandarin Lessons

As part of the 1+2 Language initiative, pupils in Primary 4 to 7 will receive Mandarin lessons this term. Each class will receive a six-week block of lessons starting with Primary 6 to link in with their 'China' topic. The first session of this was scheduled to have taken place on Friday 11th January 2019 but was postponed by Calderside until later in the term.

Parking Congestions in the local area

Please continue to support the safety of pupils/staff throughout the duration of the building works by not using the school car park. However, we ask that you are considerate to the local residents of the streets surrounding the school by not obstructing access.

Parent Teacher Consultations

The second Parent/Teacher consultation sessions will take place on Tuesday 26th March (3.30pm-5.30pm) and Thursday 28th March 2019 (6-8pm). Letters will be issued after the February long weekend to allow parents to identify the day that they would prefer. Easter Service- Friday 29th March 2019


