### Literacy and English

- **Listening and Talking:** Watch CBBC Newsround: summarise main points of the episode, answer questions and create 2 questions of your own to ask someone.
- **Reading:** Read a story of your choice, or listen to story on audible/World of David Walliams. **See reading Bingo for suggested follow up activities.**

**Writing:** Write a letter to one of your friends telling them what you have been doing whilst not at school.

- **Phonics/Common Words:** Continue practising phonemes and common words using spelling strategies/games such as noughts and crosses, hangman, rainbow spelling, pyramid spelling etc.  
**Dahl** – Revise weeks 9 and 10 phonemes and common words (Stage 3)  
**Morpurgo** – Revise weeks 26-27 phonemes and common words (Stage 2)  
**Rowling** – Revise week 13 phoneme and common words (Stage 2)  
**Walliams** – make a list of 'en' rhyming words e.g. hen, pen, when, men
- **Grammar:** Using interesting verbs and adverbs to make a story more interesting.
