Literacy and English

Phonics – Introduce a new joined phoneme e.g. ch, ng. Access Jolly Phonics online (you tube) to hear phoneme and phoneme songs. On YouTube, access Mr Thorne does phonics for fun and interactive way to hear phonemes.

- Make alphabet/phonetic cards and new joined phoneme cards. Use 5 fingered strategy to make words matching phoneme e.g. chop, song.
5 fingered strategy - 1. Say 2. Make 3. Blend 4. Read 5. Write
- Website – Education City. Search for new phoneme and play interactive game and print matching phoneme activity worksheet
- Draw and write, pictures and words to match related phoneme.
- Select 3 common words. Practice spelling and writing words
- Rainbow writing – use pens, crayons or paint. Have a go at writing and spelling common words.
- Reading – select a new story discuss characters and events.
- Create an alternative ending. Draw picture and have a go at writing the new ending.
- Be a text detective – make a list of all common words.
- Writing – Keep up your diary. Remember to include the day and weather. Draw accompanying pictures to detail your activities.
- Write a set of instructions – How to make a cheese sandwich (if possible, make an actual cheese sandwich). List and draw all the items required. Bread, cheese, butter, knife and chopping board. Write a simple step by step instruction guide e.g. First butter the bread. Next cut the cheese etc. until all steps are listed.

Maths and Numeracy

- Revise number stories and adding bonds. Education City – search and play Addition Impossible, Bonds Number Bonds
- Create adding sums, use concrete materials. How many altogether?
Education City – search Addition and filter results using Early** and Early*** for a selection of printable worksheets.
- Time – Look at an analogue clock. Discuss hands, face. Move hands on clock to display each hour. Practice telling the time. 1 o'clock to 12 o'clock only.
- Make a clock with moving hands. Printable version available on twinkl
- Time – Education City: search and play – Tick Tock

- Continue to play “shops” using real money and price tags on items. Continue to develop coin recognition and adding the value of coins.
- Counting coin worksheets – Math-Salamanders.com. A selection of free printable 1p, 2p, 5p coins worksheets.

Topic

- Woodland Animals - Owls:
- search and watch BBC bitesize habitats – Where do different owls live and BBC Springwatch, In a minute the barn owl.
- Create an owl fact file.
- Twinkl – print life cycle of a barn owl.
- Make an owl picture.

Other Curricular Areas

- Science – Spring. Education City – search – Flora Fact an interactive activity labelling flower part.
- Draw a bright, colourful flower, and don't forget underground. Label the parts of the flower – stem, roots, petal, leaf and flower. Add to the diagram – what do flowers need to grow? Label these additions.
- Drama – online search - BBC Lets Move Wood in the Wood.
- Digital Literacy – onto tablet/phone download the app “Scratch Jr”. This app develops early programming skills.
