



Home Learning for Primary 1a and Primary 1b

Literacy and English

- Phonics - [Access jolly phonics online](#) to sing songs and other activities linked to sounds and phonics. On YouTube, access [Mr Thorne does phonics](#) for fun and interactive way to hear phonemes.
- Draw and write, pictures and words to match to the related phoneme.
- Have a go at writing sentences with common words and words beginning with a selected phoneme. To develop understanding of sentence structure, capital letters can be written in blue pen and full stops marked with a red pen.
- Reading – Pick a story, discuss the characters and events.
- Create a character fact file – what do they look like, do and say?
- Design a new front cover for a book.
- Describe story sequence, identify, beginning, middle and end.
- Writing – Keep a diary. Write name of day and describe the weather.

Maths and Numeracy

- Revise [number stories and adding bonds](#).
- Create adding sums, use concrete materials such as cubes, toys etc. How many altogether?
- Count to 20 forwards and backwards, discuss number before, after, in between, odd and even. Write numbers onto separate paper or card, put in numeral order, remove one, what is missing number.
- Money – Make a shop, label goods with a price. Buy 1 or 2 items. What coins are used? How much is the total cost.

Topic

- People Who Help Us – select a person and create a fact file. Do they wear a uniform? What equipment or tools do they use?
- People Who Help Us – Be a chef. Write a menu, recipe or shopping list.
- People Who Help Us – Be a vet. Use stuffed animal toys and care for your pets. Create pet files include favourite foods, favourite toys and how to care for pets.
