Literacy and English

- Reading:

Listen to a book of your choice on '[Audible](#)' or read a book of your choice each day. - Predict how the story will end.

Create a character profile for one of the characters in your story.

Create a new front cover and blurb for one of your stories.

Talk about the story – discuss the beginning, middle and end.

- Spelling/Phonics

Use [elkonin boxes](#) to practise making phoneme words (already have these at home)

Play noughts and crosses and hangman with common words (children have played this in class)

Dahl – revise weeks 7 and 8 phonemes and common words

Morpurgo – revise weeks 21 – 24 phonemes and common words

Rowling – revise weeks 9 – 11 phonemes and common words.

Walliams - make a list of ug and ay rhyming families

- Writing – keep a diary of activities you have enjoyed while you are not at school.
- Practise retelling the story of 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' and make your own story map.

Maths and Numeracy

- Circles:

Revise place value – Thousands, Hundreds, Tens and Units

Revise 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times tables orally and using online games

Revise numbers to 10, 000 (number before, after, between, 1 more/less etc)

- Triangles:

Revise place value – Hundreds, Tens and Units

Revise 2, 5 and 10 times tables orally and using online games

Revise numbers to 1000 (number before, after, between, 1 more/less etc)

- Squares:
Revise place value – Tens and Units
Revise 2 times table through repeated addition (2 + 2 + 2 + 2 etc)
Revise numbers to 100 (number before, after, between, 1 more/less etc)
- Rectangles (Katelyn and Kacper):
Revise place value – Tens and Units
Revise number bonds to 10
Revise numbers to 20 (number before, after, between, 1 more/less etc)
