Literacy and English

Reading

- Choose a fiction novel and choose 2 characters to create a Visualiser for. Use this information to draw what they look like. Try to include page references or quotes to back up your descriptions. (You could describe their appearance, family life, personality etc.)
- Find 5-10 unfamiliar words in your book and use the <u>Metalinguistics</u> strategy to say what you think the words means based on the context around it and then the dictionary definition.

Spelling

• From the list provided choose between 6-10 common words each week and choose the best strategy to learn them.

Maths and Numeracy

- Practise your tables- also state multiplication/division facts e.g 9x5=45, 5x9=45, 45/9=5, 45/5=9
- Practise telling the time analogue/ digital/ 24 hour and stating time durations.
- Explore weight/ length through practical activities at home e.g. measuring food, baking.

There are lots of maths games online that you can use to practise all maths concepts e.g. <u>Top Marks</u>, RM Easimaths, <u>Sum Dog</u>, <u>Education City</u> and <u>Timestables.co.uk</u>.

Topic

- Research Climate Change.
