## **Communication and Literacy**

- Nursery Rhymes/songs-we will indicate a weekly nursery rhyme or song to learn and recite during hand washing. Rhymes for the next 2 weeks: Twinkle Twinkle (x2), Mary Had a Little Lamb (x2)
- Emergent-Reading Skills:

Extend this activity by asking your child to find objects around the house that rhyme eg sock/clock, mat/hat etc. Put them in a box and add to them when you can.

## • Letter knowledge:

- Sound Treasure Hunt game: Ask your child to go on a treasure hunt round the house collecting things that start with the 's' sound-extend this activitiy for t and a (See Data Handling task below)

  - Make letter shapes/ write your name using loose parts from around your house or garden (eg buttons, bottle lids, pasta, leaves, stones, squeezy bottle with water etc)

Literacy-Letter and Number

Number-Up to 10-counting activity

Make a set of skittles out of old plastic bottles or cardboard tubes. Using a soft ball to roll and knock

them down, count how many skittles you knock down each time.

• Shape/ Symmetry –Can you make a symmetrical blob painting? What do you



notice about both sides?

- **Pattern** -Can you make different patterns using various loose parts? <u>https://picklebums.com/loose-parts-and-pattern-pages/</u>
- **Data Handling** -See Letter Treasure Hunt task above. Ask Mum/Dad to make you a tally chart with **s t** and **a** on it. Each time you find an object starting with one of these letters. Make a tally mark beside it. When you have finished, count how many tally marks you made for each letter. Which letter had the most/least?
