Literacy and English

- Practise ch and ng phonemes (write and say phonemes, draw pictures and write words with the phonemes)
- Use letter cards provided or make your own and sound out and blend words.
- Education City Games (ch and ng) - search Sing a Song and Cheeping Chips, complete activity and matching activity sheets.
- Scrambled Spelling – Use letter cards to spell out a common word, mix up the letters. Can you unscramble the words?

- This week, read: **The King and His Wish/or a book you have at home**

 1. Access E-books at - <https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/?sellLanguage=en&mode=hub> (click My Class Login at the top).
 2. Click My Bookshelf to search for stories.
 3. Read the story and complete any activities.
- Discuss: the setting and characters. What happened at the beginning, middle, end?
- What was your favourite part? You can use the worksheet provided to draw a picture of your favourite part of the story and describe what is happening in the picture?

Maths and Numeracy

- Continue to practise number stories and adding bonds.
 - Can you use objects around the house to make a number story?
 - Can you draw a picture of a number story? See example/worksheet in additional Resources.
- Practise missing number questions, make number 1-10 cards, + and = cards. Create a number sentence eg. $2 + \underline{\quad} = 4$. Use objects to help you work out the missing number.
- Have a go at the missing number worksheet provided.
- Money: Continue to develop coin recognition. Lay out different coins, can you find the 5p? 10p? etc.

- Set up a shop/café, write price tags for the items in your shop. Can you use coins to pay for the items correctly? Can you use your adding skills to total two prices e.g. 5p and 2p = 7p.
- Topmarks Money Games (Toy Shop Money Games, Coins Game)

Triangles ▲

- Set up a shop/cafe, write price tags for the items e.g. 34p, 65p. Practise addition to 100 by totalling up the prices of the things you buy, use the strategies we have practised (see additional resources for a reminder). Can you then use the correct coins to pay?
- Topmarks Money Games (Toy Shop Money Games, Coins Game)
- Ask an adult to either tell you a price e.g. £1.25 or lay out some coins. Can you count out the correct coins? Can you count how much altogether?
- Have a go at 2, 5 and 10 times table activity sheet.
- Practise counting on in 2s, 5s and 10s. Can you count back too?
- Practise chimney sums, adding two digit numbers sheet.

Topic

Woodland Animals - Hedgehogs

- Follow along and draw your own hedgehog: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=leb-IFDhZfE> Make a jigsaw by cutting up your hedgehog drawing into, then have fun putting it back together!
- Collect leaves, twigs etc and make your own hedgehog. You could stick these onto the hedgehog outline provided, paint the outline with a fork to make spines, or make the shape of a hedgehog using play doh and decorate it.
- Could you make an information/fact book about Hedgehogs and include some interesting facts and pictures?
