Literacy and English

Phonics – Revision of joined phoneme “qu”. Access Jolly Phonics online (you tube) to hear phoneme and phoneme songs. On YouTube, access Mr Thorne does phonics for fun and interactive way to hear phonemes.

- Use 5 fingered strategy to make words “qu” e.g. quack, quiz.
5 fingered strategy - 1. Say 2. Make 3. Blend 4. Read 5. Write
(use previously made alphabet cards, add “qu” to the set)
- Website – Education City – search - queen’s quiz – “qu” interactive game and activity worksheet.
- Draw and write, pictures and words to match – “qu”
- Write a silly sentence with – “qu” (The queen said quack to the quick duck.)
- Select 3 common words - Play quick spell common words.
In 20 seconds how many times can you write common word. Repeat for other common words.
- Common words interactive games – Education City – play – Sparkler and Kuko Run filter for early level**
- Reading – Listen and enjoy Aliens Love Underpants -

- Writing – Write a list of all the things you need to take with you on a journey into space.
- Writing – “An Alien Came to Visit” Write a story of your encounter with an alien, illustrate pictures to retell your story. Think about. Setting – Where the story takes place. Characters – who is in the story. Events – What happens in the story, remember to think about your feelings.

Please note that all Education City interactive games suggested are set as homework and can be accessed when your child has logged in to Education City. I can track the children’s progress; please do not feel under pressure to complete these activities they are only suggestions.

Maths and Numeracy

- Revise number stories and adding bonds. Education City – search and play Addition games – Sleepy Sheep and Water Raider
- Time – Look at an analogue clock. Practise telling the time. 1 o'clock to 12 o'clock.
- Time – Education City: search and play – Tick Tock
- Time – Days of the Week – Education City: search and play Sten's Week. Can you write the days of the week in the correct order?
- Money – Education City: search and play - Dino Day Out. Developing coin recognition
- Money – keep playing at shops with real money. How much? What coins do I need?
- Measure – Do you have a tape measure? Or a ruler? Measure items around the home. What is the longest? What is the shortest? Can you put them into size order?
- Measure – Look at your toys – action figures, teddies, dolls, cars – What is the tallest? What is the smallest? Can you put them in size order?
- Pattern – Make underpants for your Alien. Spotty bloomers, stripy y fronts.

Topic

- Woodland Animals – online search and Watch – BBC Bitesize How the changing seasons affect hedgehogs KS1. <http://bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zq9rkqt>
- Hedgehogs - create a fact file for a hedgehog. What does it eat? Do hedgehogs hibernate? Does a hedgehog have fur? Where does a hedgehog make its nest?
- Make a hedgehog picture. Label your picture include – claws, spines, nose, eyes.
- Explore different the different animal habitats. Education City: search and play – creatures of Habitat

Other Curricular Areas

- Science – Planting a seed. If possible, plant some seeds. Look after your seedling, take pictures and record how it grows.
Education City: search and play – Pick a Tomato (Not tablet friendly)
Spring walk: Look for the changes of Spring. Draw pictures, take photographs, record your findings to illustrate how Spring has sprung.
- Drama - BBC Let's Move Wood in the Wood – Making things with Wood Ep 2 <http://bbc.co.uk/programmes/b03g6hch>
- Technology – Aliens Love Underpants – Make a rocket, use card, plastic bottles etc. Make and design underpants, use scissors practise cutting them out.
- Art – Aliens Love Underpants – paint, draw and colour some Aliens. Recreate the story using all your props.
- PE – Got any hula hoops, skipping ropes, bat and balls?
Play Keepie Uppie. How many spins with your hula hoop? How many jumps with your rope? Beat your own score!!

- PE – Got a trampoline – Practise your jumping skills, star jumps, straight jumps and tuck jumps. Be safe!
