



Google Classroom and Homework Guidance for Parents/ Carers

Homework, as with many things, will look a bit different this year! To ensure consistency across the school, we will be using Google Classroom to set all of our homework tasks. It is important that your child can access the Google Classroom from home and have their password noted somewhere safe.

In addition, please contact the school office if you have limited access to ICT equipment. SLC are endeavouring to assist families with this and may be able to help.

Your child has been issued with a card with their username and password on it. Please keep this in a safe place. In the event of a further lockdown/ self-isolation, Google Classroom will be used to facilitate learning and maintain contact with the school.

Format of Homework

Primary 1

Primary 1 should refer to the guidance from Miss Casey and Miss Bell/ Mrs Mitchell as this will look slightly different to the rest of the school.

Primary 2-7

Homework will be uploaded to Google Classroom on a Monday and should be completed throughout the week. Specific completion details may be given by the class teacher.

Homework will be completed in one of two ways:

- A homework jotter
- An editable document on Google Classroom

Homework jotters should be returned to school on a Friday where teachers will make a visual check of completed work. Class teachers may assign a task that can be completed and returned on Google Classroom, therefore, it may not always be necessary to record this in the homework jotter. Please see below for some examples of homework.

Pupils should attempt all tasks, however, the assigned tasks should be completed as a minimum. Please don't hesitate to contact the school if you require any further information or support.
