#### **Daily Questions**

Each morning, your child's key worker will 'check-in' by sending a message and asking a question for your child to think about and discuss with an adult. You are encouraged to answer each day by replying on the Learning Journals.

#### **Daily Learning Activities from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January**

Mrs McCleneghen and the Early Years Workers will work together to produce a number of activities for you and your child to complete together. These activities will focus on all areas of the curriculum and take a play-based approach. They will provide challenge and progression for your child and they will be fun!

For each curricular area, there will be 5 suggested activities uploaded each Monday which can be completed daily throughout the week but can be flexible to your needs. While we recommend that the Literacy and Numeracy tasks are attempted, there is no expectation for all of the other activities to be completed. These other additional activities have been provided to ensure your child has a variety of choice or, if he/ she shows an interest in a particular area, then there are extra activities to continue and extend their learning.

We encourage you to share your child's learning by taking a photograph of them taking part in the activities suggested and uploading it to their Learning Journal. We will use the uploads to track this learning and provide next steps.

We aim to provide a variety of activities that can be done around the house using everyday objects and that require minimal preparation. There will also be some tasks which will develop fine and gross motor skills. Most of all, these activities should be fun and engaging for the whole family. We are excited to see your uploads!

### **Daily Story/ Nursery Rhymes**

We will post daily videos of a story or nursery rhyme for you to listen to or join in with. Again, this is something we hope you can enjoy together.

### **Phone Calls Home**

Our key workers will be in touch via telephone at least once a fortnight to find out how your child is and answer any queries you may have. Please keep an eye on your child's Learning Journal for possible dates and times of these calls. Please contact the nursery via the school office if any of your contact details have changed.

### **Live Stream Learning**

Please keep an eye on the Learning Journals and the school Twitter page for information about some Live Google Meet sessions. Over the next few days, you will be supplied with an email and password for your child's Glow account which will be used to access these sessions.

We politely remind you to login to your child's Learning Journal daily to ensure you are up-to-date with any new information.

We look forward to seeing your photographs as you share what you get up to.

As you will be aware, the nursery staff will be working in the Emergency Childcare Hubs on a rota basis, therefore, may not be able to respond to queries right away. However, if there is anything you wish to

discuss urgently please contact the nursery via the school office where someone will be able to assist you.
