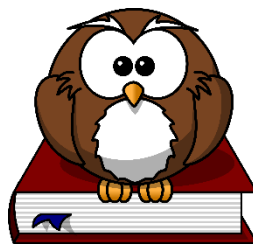

'Share A Story Reading Stars' Game

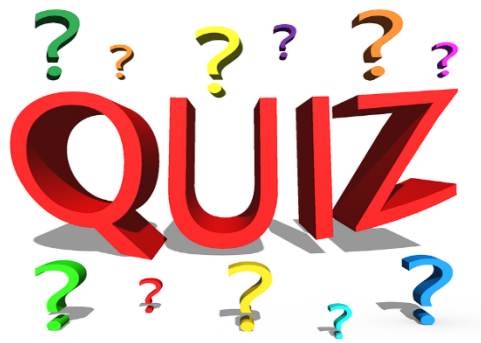
