



## Woodhead Primary School and Nursery Class

### Information about the next phase of reopening from 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021

From 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021, Primary 4-7 will return to school full-time.

This document provides information specific to Woodhead Primary School about this next phase of reopening for all parents of P1-7 pupils.

#### COVID-Secure Arrangements

All of the COVID-secure arrangements in place prior to Christmas will remain in place. These include:

- One way system in the playground for collection and drop-off of pupils.
- A limit of one parent per family permitted to come into the playground for drop-off and collection.
- Soft-entry for P1-7 pupils from 8.45am-9am
- Entry to classrooms for P1-7 pupils via their dedicated doors
- Staggered drop-off and pick-up for nursery pupils.
- Children working in their class bubbles whilst in school.
- Children playing in their dedicated playground area.
- Separate areas for packed lunches and school dinners to maintain separation of bubbles in communal dining spaces.

**As the First Minister has stressed the importance of limiting contact between adults, please ensure you adhere to 2m distancing at all times when dropping off/collecting children.**

## Arrangements for Primary 1-7 Pupils

From 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021, P4-7 will return to school meaning all pupils in P1-7 will in school full-time.

Pupils should arrive between 8.45am and 9am. They should proceed straight into the building via the same previously designated door.

**(The gate will be opened at 8.40am to allow nursery pupils to enter for the 8.45am drop-off. P1-7 will not be permitted to enter the grounds until 8.45am. Please avoid any queues forming at the gate by not arriving before this time.)**

Pupils will be dismissed from the same door at 3pm. Only one parent/carer per family should attend for drop-off/collection.

## Arrangements for pupils in P3 and P3/4 Composite Class.

The P4 pupils in P3/4 will re-join their classmates and be taught together by Mrs. Mackie.

Mrs. McPhee will continue to teach P3 for the time being.

## Break/Lunch Arrangements

Children will remain in separate class 'bubbles' as they did before Christmas, with an allocated area of the playground and dining areas.

From 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021, times for breaks/lunchtimes will be the same as before Christmas:

### **Morning Break:**

P2, P2/3 P4, P4/5, P5, P5/6 and P6: 10.20am-10.35am

P1a, P1b, P3, P3/4, P6/7 and P7: 10.45am-11am

### **Lunchtime:**

P2, P2/3 P4, P4/5, P5, P5/6 and P6: 12.10am-12.55pm

P1a, P1b, P3, P3/4, P6/7 and P7: 12.40am-1.25pm

*Children are discouraged from going home for lunch to avoid unnecessary additional contacts during the school day.*

## **One Way System**

Maps to remind you of the one-way system in place at the start and end of the school day are included at the end of this document.

Please share this information with all parents/carers/grandparent etc. if they assist with the school run.

## **School Uniform**

School uniform should be worn and it is recommended that this is laundered as often as possible to comply with COVID-19 guidelines.

If your child has outgrown their uniform and you need help with any items, please get in touch. We have some new and pre-loved uniform available.

Pupils in P7 may wear their Leavers' Hoodie to school as soon as they get them. Again, these should be laundered regularly to comply with COVID-19 guidelines. You might consider this being worn for PE days.

## **Lunch Areas**

As per previous arrangements, school lunches will be served in the dining hall and packed lunches will be eaten in the gym hall

All nursery children will eat together in the school lunch hall.

## Milk

Nursery children and children eligible for a means tested free school meal will be provided with the option of milk each day. This does not need to be pre-ordered.

From 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021, milk will be available to order via ParentPay for Pupils in P1-7.

**Please remember to book the milk for the days it is required.**

## PE Lessons

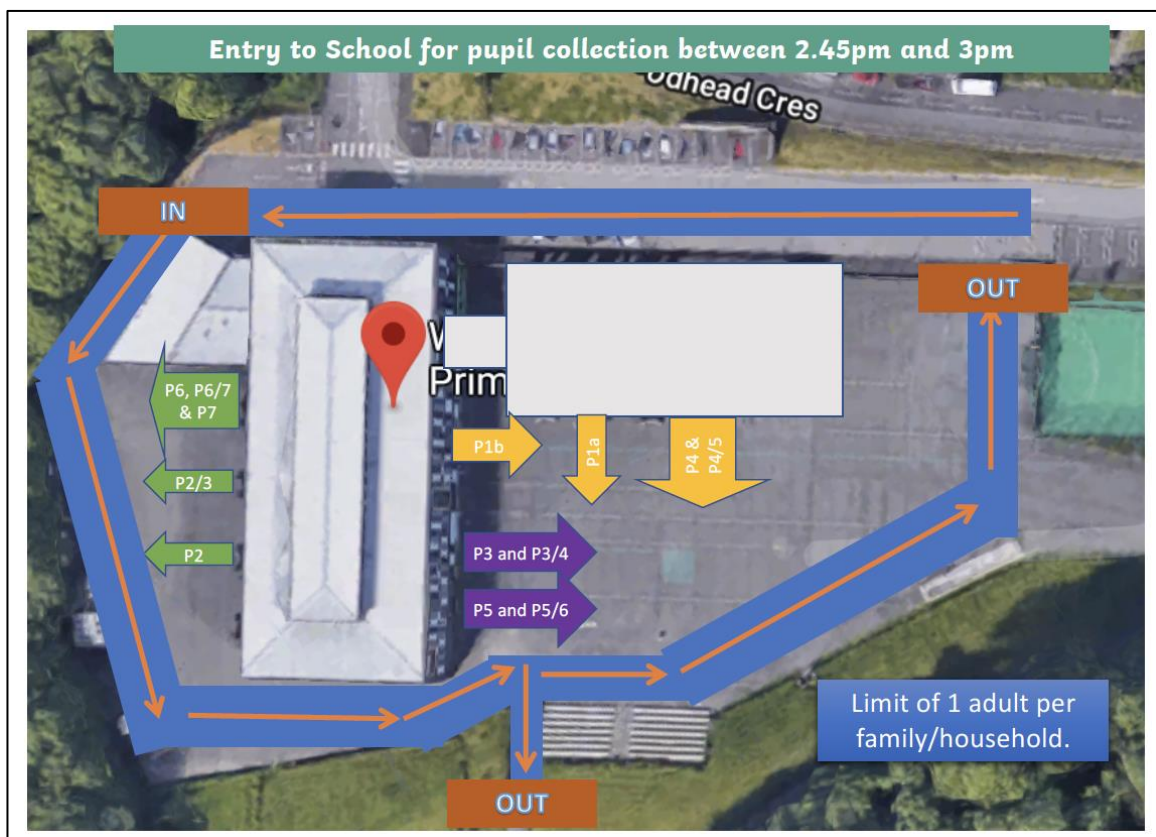
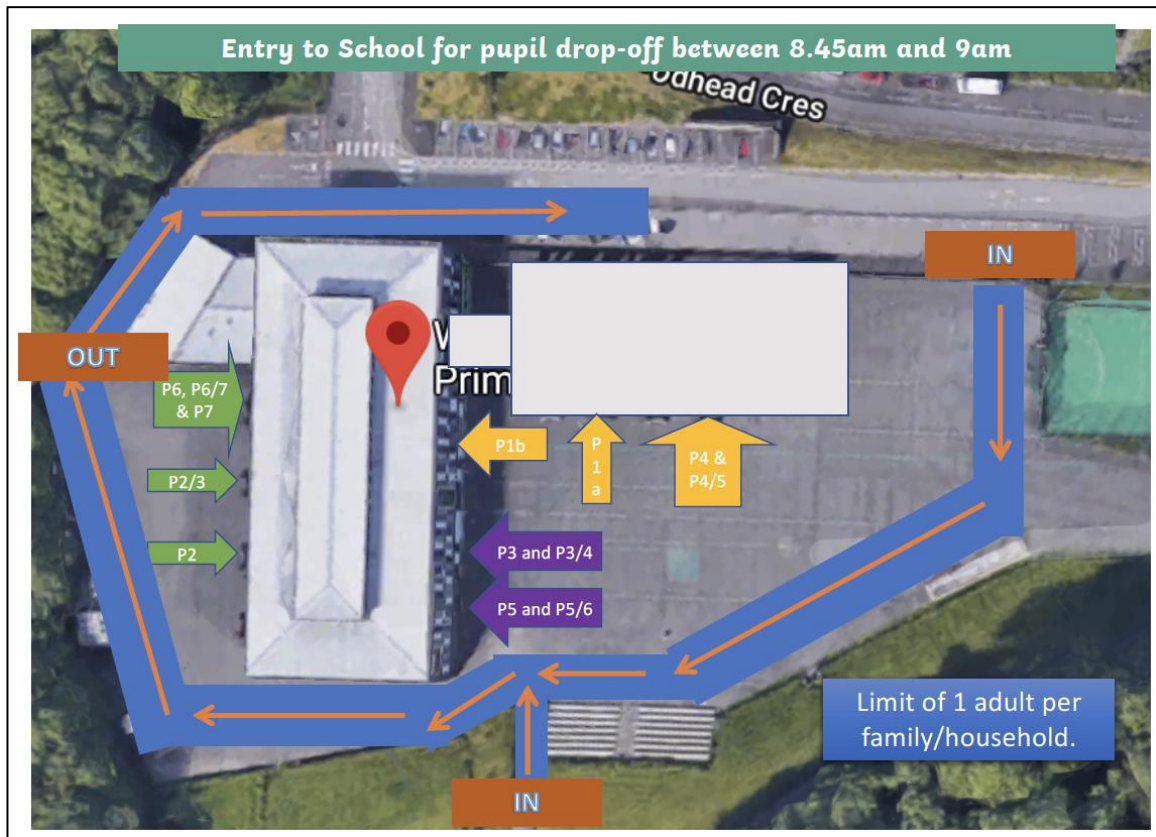
PE lessons will continue outdoors, and children are required to come to school wearing appropriate outdoor PE clothing as before Christmas.
