Who we are

- Woodhead Primary Parent Council is composed of 14 people
- -12 parent/carers of young people at the school and 2 staff representatives
- The headteacher attends the meetings and acts as an advisor but is not a member of the Parent Council.
- The Parent Council extends an invitation to the local councillors to attend their meetings and they are not a formal member of the Parent Council
- Our meetings take place usually on the first Tuesday of the month from September to June (except for January and April)
- Our AGM takes place in September and all parents are invited to attend
- Parents may attend any meetings providing they have prearranged with the chairperson.

What we do

Our objectives are:

- To work in partnership with the school to create a welcoming school that is inclusive for all parents/carers
- To promote partnership between the school, its pupils and all its parents/carers
- To develop and engage in activities which support the education and welfare of the pupils
