Stomach Bugs.

Following some recent confusion regarding children attending nursery when poorly the following information is to clarify what to do when your child has an upset stomach.

If your child is ill prior to attending the session phone and inform the school office.

Your child cannot attend nursery for a full 48 hours following their last bout of vomiting and diarrhoea

This is to prevent the spread of infection amongst the children and staff.

Social Security Scotland

We recently promoted the newly introduced **Early Learning Grant** from Social Security Scotland. The purpose of this grant is to reduce the inequalities faced by some children. We were pleased to assist you in this matter and were happy to hear this information had been helpful.

The School Age Payment will also be a payment of £250 per child, paid in the year your child normally starts school. The School Age Payment launches on 3rd June 2019 and is in addition to any school clothing grants available from South Lanarkshire Council.

Parent Pay

This term's snack and toy fund payment must be made no later than **28th June 2019.** This fund helps us to buy additional equipment to support children's learning and contribute to trips, outings, visitors, and special treats for the children.
