1. Welcome

Fiona thanked everybody for coming and welcomed new members to the Parent Council.

2. Minutes of previous meeting – 12 May 2015

6. Headteacher's report

> Attainment

Elaine was very pleased to share the significant improvement in Balfron High School's attainment in the National Qualifications sat in May 2015. A high number of young people achieved highly in National 5's, Highers and Advanced Highers. There were also a number of notable achievements for younger pupils sitting assessments in Languages and Music. The methodology that is used to compare and track the attainment of pupils was clearly explained.

Balfron High School continues to improve standards and achievement across the board in comparison to schools in Stirlingshire and in comparison to our Virtual Comparator.

Parents and Partners

The results from the surveys undertaken in June by parents and pupils were examined in detail. Surveys were returned by parents of approximately 20% of families attending BHS. Generally the results were positively supporting the actions of the school. Where concerns were raised these have been addressed personally.

Show My Homework is being updated for the new session – it is not up and running yet.

Monthly Drop-ins with Elaine Bannatyne continue, and Parent Zone on the school website has information regarding school meetings and letters home.

The school Twitter account (@Balfronhigh) is very active. All the daily tannoy announcements and happenings in the school are posted here.

> Learning and Teaching

The staff in the school practice a co-operative learning approach, Tri-Learning. Members of staff observe on other lessons within their departments. This leads in to discussions relating to best practice and ensures that all staff are encouraged to improve continually (CPD) Justin Noon explained how this works in the Maths Department detailing the benefits to staff.

Curriculum

S1 residential is about to depart for 2015 (wb 14th Sep). S4 Work Experience is scheduled for the same week (wb 14th Sep).

The school is currently reviewing the school day and curriculum with a view to moving to a 33 period week in June 2016. The availability of the buses is crucial in this process. A new 33 period week will see days of differing lengths and will unfortunately mean a reduction in teaching staff. Elaine Bannatyne is keen to meet with a group of parents to obtain views on this process.

National Qualifications

The new Advanced Highers are new being taught from this session.

Following the exams in June, there are a number of re-calculations and remarks awaited.

7. Treasurer's Report
