Assessment National 5

- Course assignment may be externally marked
- Most subjects have an exam (not PE)
- Unit option



Assessment National 4

- 2 or 3 unit assessments in every course
- Unit assessments are marked internally by the school
- Pupils must pass all unit assessments and added value unit to gain an overall award
 - Often a project or investigation but depends on the subject
 - This assesses the skills and knowledge gained in all other units
- No external exam
