- If you are applying for a FVC Friday course &/or FA, write the name of the course in the space, but still make all your school choices for June (as courses start in August)
- Your option choices and appropriate initial levels of study will be discussed at the S4 Form Class Leader interviews 20 February - 1 March 2018
- Classes can only run if there are enough pupils to make the class viable
- Classes can only run if there is a subject specialist available to teach the class
- If a subject is oversubscribed, you may have to pick this up in S6
- We will always try to give you your first 5 choices, but may need to use your alternative choice. In this case you will be re-interviewed. Subjects run in columns, and it may be that we cannot give you all your desired choices because of the columns your chosen subjects are in.
- Make sure you have thoroughly researched which subjects you need to study for your preferred destination/future pathway.
