Available to current S4 pupils who will be going into S5:

Foundation Apprenticeships

- work-based learning opportunities
- gain an industry recognised qualification at college (often an SVQ)
- spend time with local employers on work experience placement and complete your other subjects like National 5s and Highers at school.
- A Foundation Apprenticeship can lead straight into a job, further study at college or university, or a fast-track Modern Apprenticeship (equivalent to level 6-Higher)
- **S4 pupils must enrol in the 2-year foundation apprenticeship options**
- choose as one of your course choices
- pupils can change into college appropriate clothing before leaving for college
- no transport costs to pupils – a minibus will be provided to take you to FVC or a Stirling School on a Monday and Wednesday afternoon.

School Partnership (Friday) courses:

- Pupils will attend Forth Valley College (FVC) every Friday
- Pupils **pay a contribution** every week towards the cost of the transport between school and Stirling Campus of Forth Valley College
- Pupils will wear college appropriate clothes rather than school uniform
- Pupils will register at reception with a member of the office staff, they do not attend form class
- The transport will leave sharp at 9am – pupils **must arrive at reception by 8.50am**
- Transport will pick pupils up at 2.15pm at Stirling Campus and bring them back to school so they can attend period 6.
Pupils **cannot** opt to **stay in Stirling**
- Pupils must catch up with class work missed while at College on a Friday between periods 1-5
