Dear Parents/Carers,

This month I have the following news items:

# **Bikeability**

Well done to all of our P6 pupils, who despite some heavy rain showers, successfully completed their Bikeability 1 programme this week. Thank you to parents, Stuart Johnstone and Mark Henton, who helped staff with the delivery of Bikeability. It is our plan that P6 will complete Bikeability 2 during the spring/summer term.

## <u>Ardroy</u>

The date given to us for our P6 parent and pupil Ardroy information evening has been brought forward and will now take place on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> February at 7:00pm in the primary school

## Parents' Evening

All parents should already have received their Parents Evening appointment. It is our expectation that consultations will remain on time throughout both evenings.

'Seesaw' is used in all classes and is an effective way for learning to be shared regularly with families. Pupil jotters will also be available in school to look through at the end of appointments with teachers, rather than being sent home prior to Parents' Evening.

Additionally, parents will have an opportunity to make a written comment on their child's progress using My Next Steps in Learning booklets, which will also include targets identified by pupils and teachers.

# Children in Need Day – Friday 18th November

Pupils can come to school in non-uniform for Children in Need Day. P7 and P6 are currently working together to plan the day which will include a range of fun activities and competitions as well as getting a decorated biscuit made in school and drink of juice. There is no need for pupils to bring any money on the day – instead a donation of £2 **per family** can be made now to Children in Need through Parent Pay.

# Class Committees & Lunch Club

This year, we are looking for effective ways to increase opportunities for all pupils to share their ideas. Teachers will be talking to their classes to identify which age and stage appropriate committees to form, based on areas of interest.

Additionally P5-P7 are planning on getting involved with some local community projects with the first link already arranged where P5 will be visiting the Thursday village Lunch Club on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> December, held in Balfron Church rooms.

Tickets are free although any coin donation on the day will be used for licence costs. Any tickets not needed should be returned to school for any family that requires an extra.

## P1 enrolment 2023/23

Arrangements for enrolling pupils to start P1 in August 2023 are attached to today's newsletter. Like last year, enrolment forms are online at Stirling Council's website <u>https://www.stirling.gov.uk</u>. Please note that this year there is a requirement for parents/carers to upload copies of relevant documents and all enrolment forms should be completed by Friday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2023 at the latest.

If you are putting in a Placing Request please submit this form at the same time as your enrolment form.

Deferred entry forms must be submitted by 31 January 2023.

From August 2023, all children in Stirling with birth dates from the first day of term in August (16/08/23) until the last day in February (29/02/24) are now automatically eligible for an additional funded year of early learning and childcare.

All children with birth dates between March and the start of term in August are not eligible to defer.
