School Lunches

School meal pre-ordering will be available to parents via Parent Pay after the October break. Please find attached further details for parents along with examples of red and green trays.

VSE

This week Balfron Primary are having visitors in the school helping with a Validated Self Evaluation (VSE) process which takes place, roughly every 3 years. Heads of three other Stirling schools who work in different partnerships with our school – Braehead PS, Deanston PS and Drymen PS – will be visiting classes and talking to pupils, staff, some parents and other agencies as part of a process which helps our school to validate its own established self-evaluation approaches.

Balfron 720

Pupils in P5 and across P6 will be taking part in medieval writing workshops with a visiting specialist on Friday, thanks to the organisation of Balfron's historical community group which is commemorating the 720th birthday of Balfron village through activities in the village, Balfron High and our own school.

1-2-1 Cycling Lessons

Recyke-a-bike are running some 121 cycling lessons over the October break. These are 30 minute sessions intended for students who would like to learn to cycle or improve their confidence. All lessons take place at Recyke-a-bike in Stirling and the team are able to lend a bike and helmet to anyone that needs them.
