Dear Parents/Carers,

This month, I have the following news items to share:

Summer Fayre

Hygiene

We have had several Chickenpox absences recently and therefore remind parents/carers to help reduce the spread children with Chickenpox should be kept off school for at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over.

Handwashing is particularly important and this message is also being reinforced in school.

Should I keep my child off school or childcare?

Yes

Illness	Until...
Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the advice on NHS inform if they've tested positive for COVID-19
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

- Children's dates of birth
- Gender – to ensure a good mix of boys and girls
- Additional needs – to ensure a spread across classes


